## BASICS

- Shovel, windshield scraper, and small broom
- Headlamp and spare batteries
- Crank-powered emergency radio.
- Hygiene kit
  - Toilet paper
  - Baby wipes
  - Trash bags
  - Feminine items
  - Diapers (if you have an infant)
- Hats, socks, mittens, jacket, and boots
- Blankets and/or sleeping bags
- Bivy Bag
- First aid kit



## EMERGENCY SIGNALING

- Phone plus charger
- Roadside flares
- Reflectors (put next to your vehicle to increase visibility)
- Whistle
- Fluorescent distress/HELP flag
- Notepad and pencil (in case you evacuate- leave a note saying where you are headed)



## EMERGENCY HEAT SOURCES

- Hand warmers
- Duct tape + trash bags
- Candles
- Indoor-Safe Heater



## CAR TOOLS AND SPARES

- Spare tire, jack, and lug wrench
- Can of tire inflator and sealant
- Tow chain - this one is highly rated
- Spare fuses
- Road salt, sand, or cat litter
- Booster cables
- Motor oil
- Antifreeze, coolant, and windshield washer fluid
- Pocket knife and multi-tool



## FOOD AND WATER

- Energy bars
- Candy bars
- Raisins other dried fruits
- Bottled water
- Tin can or pot for heating water or melting snow
- Matches
- Stove or candles
- Water filter or purification
